INTERVENTIONS

Interventions in public space create liveable and sustainable places, where children and adults alike are happy to socialise and play. “A city for people”

AIM

The aim of interventions in public space is to discourage car use and encourage greater sustainable mobility by all citizens. Resulting in a decrease of harmful effects of motorised vehicles on children, while promoting health benefits of active mobility, improving the accessibility and community usage of public spaces.

GOALS

- **Empower** children to take ownership of the public spaces in their neighbourhood
- Raise children's **awareness** for the topic “public space” and for the space parking spots require
- Show people an **alternative** for the usage of public space

Examples

Walking Trees- Munich, Graz

During the implementation of the project, “mobile trees” are located in an asphalt dominated area to transform it over a course of several weeks into a green public space with plenty of social interaction

Skate ramp- Meran

A local square was transformed into a playing area for youngsters through the construction of a skate ramp. This is the result of a co-creation process carried on in the previous 6-months by the municipality through several vision building workshops, where children, parents and local inhabitants dreamt about more diverse use of public space.

The Urban Library- Alba Iulia

The Urban Library is the result of a partnership between the municipality, a local architecture company and Transavia. The project consists of 10 small library- boxes placed in 9 locations in Alba Iulia. Each library has books for children and small events are organised around them.
